- 1. Equation has equal signs between expressions. Example: y=6x + 3
- 2. Expression Math statement that does not contain an equal sign. Example in this Equation: y=6x + 3. (6x + 3) fits this description or (y) fits this description.
- 3. Term Product of numbers & variables (letters). Example of this in this Equation: y=6x + 3; (y) or (6x) or (3) fits this description.
- 4. Variable A letter that expresses (holds the place) of an Unknown Number. Example: y=6x + 3; (y) or (x) fits this description. y is an unknown number. x is an unknown number.
- 5. Constant Fixed number on its own (no variables or unknown numbers with it). Example in this Equation: y=6x+ 3; (3) fits this description.
- 6. Coefficient A number in front of a variable (letter) in a term. Example in this Equation: y=6x + 3;
