

- 1. Do not eat unclean birds, as the eagle, hawk, owl, swan, bat, stork, etc...
- 2. Do not eat the first fruit of the harvest before you offering unto YHWH
- The Children of Israel will be holy because Yah is holy and they will not cut their flesh for the dead or make tattoo on their bodies
- 4. Ye shall not eat of anything that dieth of itself: thou shalt give it unto the stranger that is in thy gates, that he may eat it; or thou mayest sell it unto an alien:
- 5. Do not eat any animal killed by another animal
- 6. if a bird's nest chance to be before thee in the way in any tree, or on the ground, whether they be young ones, or eggs, and the dam sitting upon the young, or upon the eggs, thou shalt not take the dam with the young: But thou shalt in any wise let the dam go, and take the young to thee; that it may be well with thee, and that thou mayest prolong thy days
- 7. Do not drink wine nor strong drink, thou, nor thy sons with thee, when ye go into the tabernacle of the congregation, lest ye die: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations:
- 8. Do not eat anything with leaven during the Feast of Unleaven Bread
- 9. And every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth shall be an abomination:
- Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an set-apart convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls,
- 11. Only eat lawful flying creeping things, like the locust, beetle or grasshopper for food
- 12. Yet these may ye eat of every flying creeping thing that goeth upon all four, which have legs above their feet, to leap withal upon the earth; Even these of them ye may eat; the locust after his kind, and the bald locust after his kind, and the beetle after his kind, and the grasshopper after his kind.
- 13. Do not eat an animal that killed someone

- Do not eat unclean animals that do not chew the cud or is not clove footed: as camel, pig, rabbit or coney
- 15. And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be holy: for I YHWH your Elohim am holy. Ye shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor print any marks upon you: I am Yahuwah.
- 16. You can only eat animals in the water that have fins and scales for food
- 17. Never eat fat from an animal
- 18. Do not eat any animal that dies of itself
- 19. You can take baby chickens and eggs, but let the mother bird go free
- 20. "And Elohim said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat."
- 21. and there shall no leavened bread be seen with thee, neither shall there be leaven seen with thee in all thy quarters.
- 22. And ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched corn, nor green ears, until the selfsame day that ye have brought an offering unto your Elohim: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.
- 23. neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- 24. These ye shall eat of all that are in the waters: all that have fins and scales shall ye eat:
